



Mount Baker Boys & Girls Club



Beginning September 17th the Mount Baker Boys & Girls Club in conjunction with the Mount Vernon School District will be meeting after school at the Mount Baker Middle School. This program is offered Monday-Thursday from 2-5pm. All students who sign up will also be registered Mount Vernon Boys & Girls Club members allowing them the opportunity to take advantage of other Club programs and activities at the Mount Vernon site. On Friday's program participants are welcome to join in after-school activities and Teen Nights at the Mount Vernon Club, located on the LaVenture Middle School property. While we encourage members and families to take advantage of all 4 days per week, this is a drop-in program and it is not required that members attend daily to participate.

- The Daily Schedule will be:
 - 2-2:30-snack, hang-out, fun (Members **must sign in by 2:15** to participate and take the bus)
 - 2:30-3:30-Homework help, academic learning time, educational activities
 - 3:30-4:15 enrichment programs, Character and Citizenship, STEM, Healthy Lifestyles
 - 4:15-Pick-up/Bus to Laventure for Dinner
 - 5:00-Transportation home from Laventure provided by the school district
- At 4:15 members will be transported to LaVenture for dinner and transportation home.
- Members will be able to choose what activities they participate in during the 3:30-4:30 hour.
- Family nights and Family engagement is an important part of the Mount Baker Boys & Girls Club and important for your child's success. There will be opportunities throughout the year for parent involvement.
